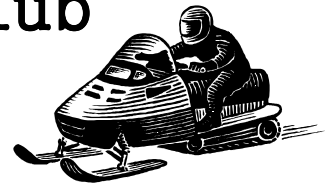


Poor Folks Snowmobile Club

Special Meeting Notice

We will be holding an off season special meeting at the clubhouse on Irwin Road on Tuesday July 26, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. This meeting will be to discuss installation of a concrete slab floor in the groomer barn. Members can expect to discuss and vote on this proposal at this meeting. This will allow us to have this completed prior to beginning pre-season maintenance activities on the groomer in preparation for the winter.

MEMBERSHIP

The New York State DMV will soon be mailing snowmobile registration renewals for the 2011-2012 season. Your club membership provides you with a registration voucher which saves you money. Registration Vouchers are now available and you must renew your Poor Folks Snowmobile Club membership. You may either renew your membership online or by mail.

Enter your six-digit NYSSA ID number and your password. Your six-digit NYSSA ID number can be found on your membership card or on last years' voucher; or you can contact the club by emailing poorfolkssnowmobileclub@frontiernet.net.

If you've forgotten your password, enter your six-digit NYSSA ID number and click on the 'RESET PASSWORD' button for instructions.

If you are a first time member and do not have a NYSSA ID at the login screen select **Register** to setup an account and ensure to select Poor Folks Snowmobile Club listed under Cayuga County.

If you do not wish to join online you may send a check made out to Poor Folks Snowmobile Club in the amount of \$25.00 to club Treasurer Dorian Cole. Please complete and enclose the attached registration form. Please allow 2 – 3 weeks for processing and you will receive your registration voucher in the mail.

If you join the club online or provide your email address you will automatically receive your monthly newsletter via email. If you wish to receive a hard copy of the newsletter each month please specifically specify on your application or contact us. 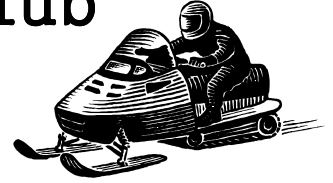
TRAILS
